Items discussed:

August 8 District Picnic: - Bolton Park 6:00 pm.

Mike P - At least one representative of Pack 940 needs to attend to receive info from the Council for the new year (Council Calendar, materials for Scout Night, etc.).

Sloane P. – Can probably attend.

August 22 School Recruitment Night for Scouting:

Mike P. - Pack 940 normally sets up a recruitment table and signs up new Scouts and adult Leaders at Cash, Piney Grove and Kernersville Elementary School.
