#### **Popcorn Sale:**

Popcorn meeting on Sept. 11. All popcorn materials will be distributed to Den Leaders at the Pack Meeting on September 15.

- Popcorn forms should be given to Scouts before the October 1 sale start date.
- Den Leaders urged to remind Scouts and parents of dates of sale.
- All Den leaders will receive paperwork with dates and prize information.
- Since the Council is offering a multitude of prizes at different levels this year, the Pack will give one monetary prize to the top pack seller matching the Council \$\$\$. For example: Sales of \$750. = \$30.00 prize money, \$1000 = \$45 prize money
- Encourage competition among boys, set goal of \$300 sales per scout.
