Items discussed:

Pack Finances:

Cyndi Pigg passed out reports and went over account balances, expenses and income. She also passed out and went over the 2002-2003 Pack Budget including the allotment for each Den which works out to approximately \$15 per scout. Expense re-imburement forms were also passed out to all leaders.

Parent Son Family Camporee – Saturday, October 19:

Mike Piombino confirmed that our Pack has secured adirondack campsites Crazy Horse A, Crazy Horse B, Jim Bridger and the adjacent field for tent camping. Anyone who needs to come later will need to check in at the camp office and get directions to the campsite. Everyone should bring a lunch for Saturday, supper, Sunday breakfast and a Saturday evening cracker barrel are included if you paid \$15. Bring your own food if you paid the \$9 price. OK to bring Coleman stoves or grills. Opening ceremony is expected to be around 1 pm. Please be sure to help clean up the campsite Sunday morning before leaving.

Pack Meeting/ Halloween Party – Monday October 21, 7 pm:

Den 7 is responsible for setup/cleanup. Scouts may come in costume or in uniform to be eligible for the monthly drawing and must be present at the end of the meeting when the drawing is held. There will be a short formal meeting before the Halloween party begins. We'll have a contest for the best costume. Each Den can decorate a pumpkin (not carved – just colored with magic markers, etc.) & there will be a contest for the best decorated pumpkin. Refreshments and snacks will be available. Den Leaders should bring a roll or two of toilet paper so that each Scout will have an opportunity to turn their Den Leader into a mummy.
