Finances:

- \$103.00 still not collected from 7 scouts for 2003 registration (the pack paid the council for their renewal but has not been reimbursed).
- Class B Uniforms (T-Shirts) cost \$997 and \$460 worth of T-Shirts have been purchased so far.
- Unspent money from each Den's allotment will be rolled into a holding account to help pay the way on the Yorktown trip when that Den reaches Webelos II. (Also, Troop 940 has agreed to allow us to use their bus for the Yorktown trip this year).
- On the Pack Picnic we spent \$240.00 and received a total of \$220.00 from the \$10 per family that was charged.
- The pack paid \$1295 in subsidies for all of those (parents and scouts) who went to Resident Camp this past summer.

Mike Piombino Grand Slam Award: At Resident's Camp when Mike announced that he was moving to Raleigh and would no longer be Cubmaster, he presented Pack 940 with a plaque to recognize all of the Webelos II who have completed all 20 achievements. It was agreed that our first choice is to hang the plaque in the hall downstairs and our second choice is to hang it upstairs outside the rooms where all of the dens meet. Wes O'Brien said he would check with the church trustee to see where we can display the plaque.
