### Boy Scouts of America Mission Statement

The mission of the Boy Scouts of America (BSA) is to prepare young people to make ethical and moral choices over their lifetimes by instilling in them the values of the Scout Oath and Scout Law.

**Scout Oath:** On my honor I will do my best to do my duty to God and my country and to obey the Scout Law; to help people at all times; to keep myself physically strong, mentally awake, and morally straight.

**Scout Law:** A Scout is trustworthy, loyal, helpful, friendly, courteous, kind, obedient, cheerful, thrifty, brave, clean, and reverent.

### Cub Scouting and Pack 940 Overview

Cub Scouting is a family-based program designed to address the needs of younger boys and serve as an introduction into Boy Scouting. It is for boys in Kindergarten through fifth grades. Boys who are older than 10, or who have completed the fifth grade, can no longer join Cub Scouting (they would be eligible to join Boy Scouts).

Pack 940 is chartered by Main Street United Methodist Church (Kernersville) and has been serving youth for over 40 years. We are one of the largest Packs in the area. Most Scout meetings and events are held at the church.

An entire Cub Scout Pack (i.e., our Pack – Pack 940) includes all Scouts that belong to the same unit. Packs generally hold meetings once per month to recognize individual advancements and awards. Some activities (camping trips, Pinewood Derby, Scouting for Food, etc.) are also held at the Pack level. Our Pack meetings are generally held on the third Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM.

A Pack is divided into smaller groups called Dens that are assigned based on grade level. Pack 940 has at least one Den for each grade level – sometimes more than one Den to accommodate a large number of boys in the same grade. Each Den has an adult Den Leader and one or more Assistant Den Leaders.
